


To what extent does the public student support system meet the financial difficulties of students?

Share of students with delayed transition









Share of students with financial difficulties








Composition of students' funding






Recipients of public support cross-country averages






































Public support + financial difficulties by age






Who else has particularly severe financial difficulties?


(very) serious financial difficulties by parental wealth



(very) serious financial difficulties by transition




(very) serious financial difficulties by fee paying





Time comparison: (very) serious financial difficulties






Accommodation cost as share of total expenditure
