build **inclusive** and **democratic** education systems

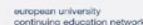

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dividing adults and young learners

- EEA prioritises formal education
- Skills Agenda prioritises adult education
- Responsibilities divided between DGs, EP Committees
- **A European Year of Skills that works against policy coherence**

Everyone and no one's responsibility

References to inclusion

- 14 in Skills Agenda
- 18 in European University Strategy
- 29 in EEA
- Headline sections - less focus on specific actions

Far from inclusion

- EEA Progress Report - equity
- Skills Agenda targets on adult participation: only at 37%
- European Universities elitism?
- NRRPs focused on hard rather than soft infrastructure

Glimmers of hope

- Council Recommendation on Pathways to School Success - wellbeing
- Proposals for Council Recommendations on digital skills - whole-of-government approaches
- Individual Learning Accounts
