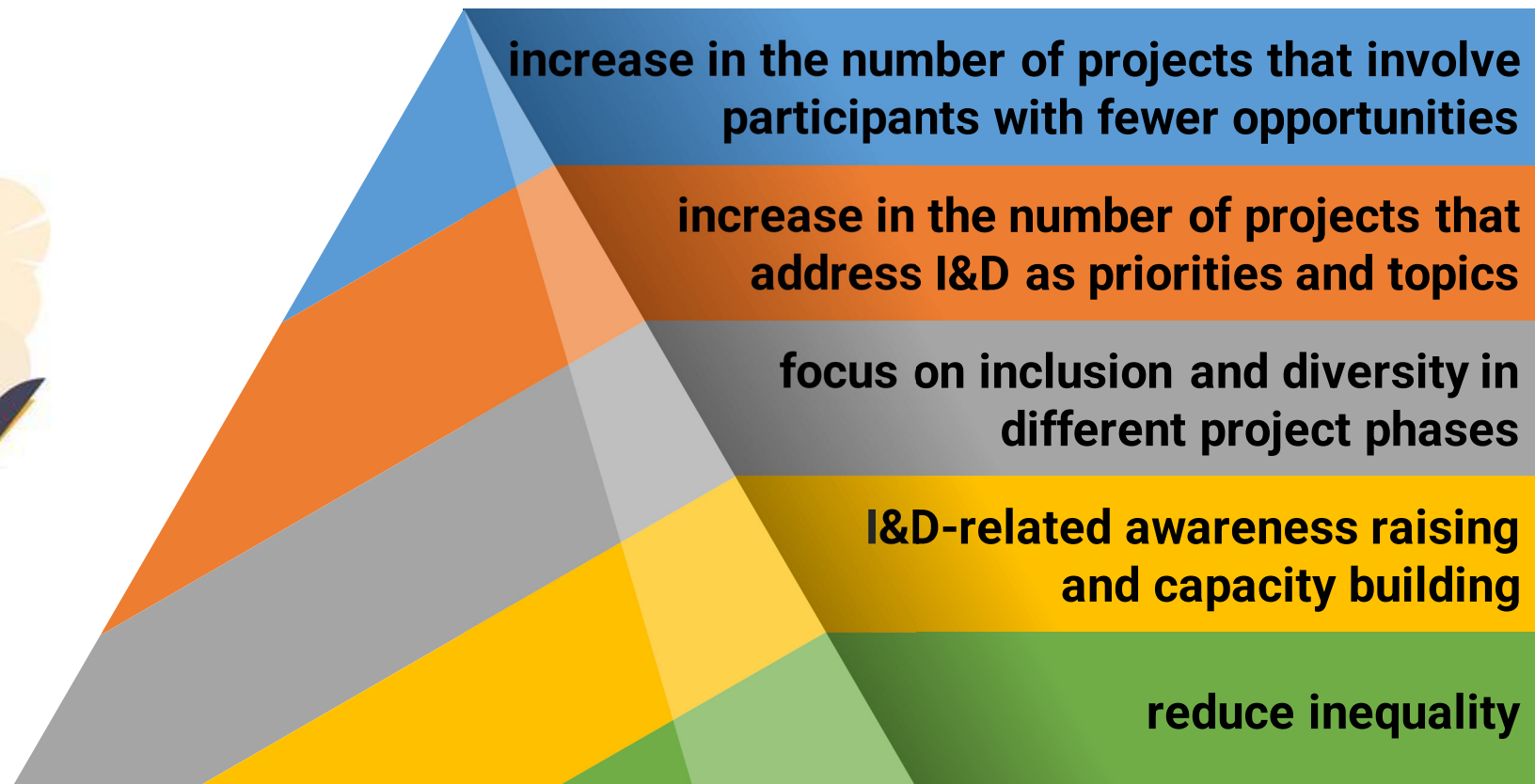
Inclusion & Diversity

 - Geographical barriers
- **Diversity** – describes all the ways in which people differ
 - the condition of having or being composed of differing elements

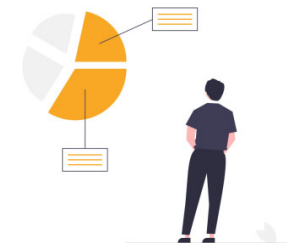
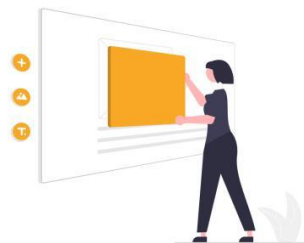
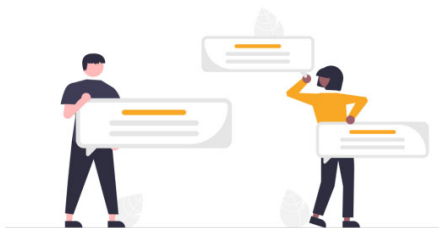
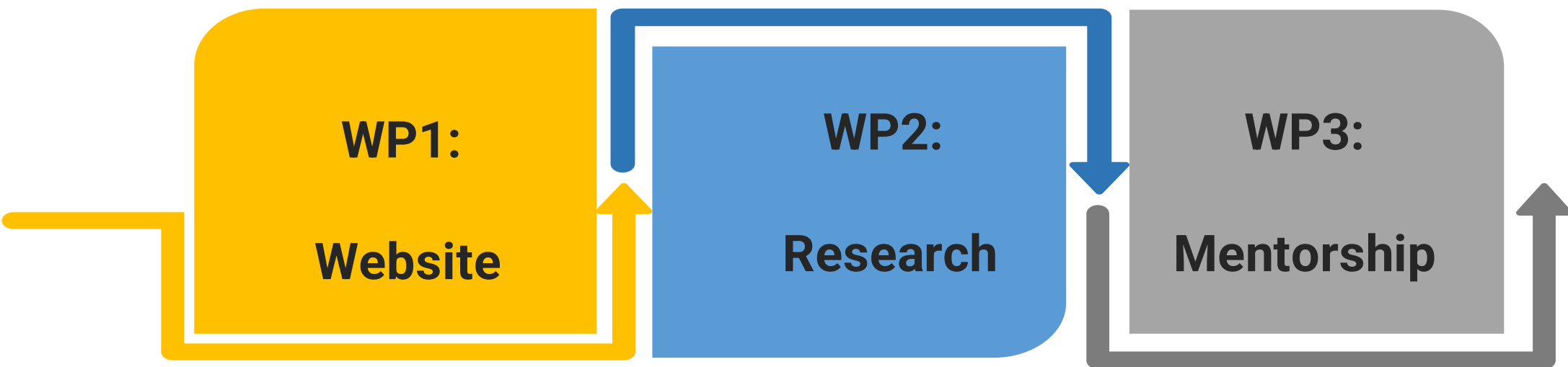
Main objective 1:

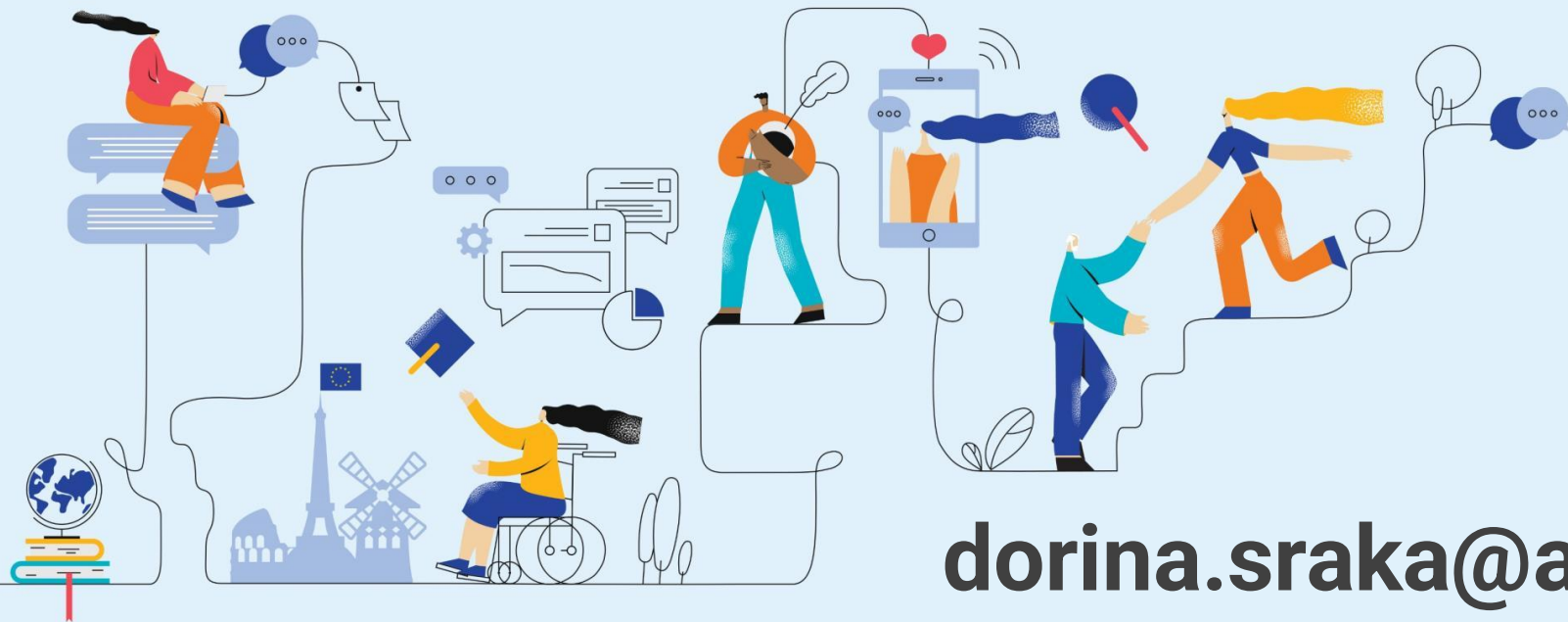
